
4350 CABINET MID-BASE BOX MOUNTING



ON EARLY MODELS THE MID BASE BOX WAS MOUNTED FLUSH TO THE INSIDE FACE OF THE BAFFLE AND WAS GLUED AND SCREWED IN PLACE. SCREW HEADS ARE VISIBLE ON THE BAFFLE FRONT.

ON LATER MODELS THE SCREWS WERE DELETED AND THE BOX WAS GLUED AND NAILED THRU THE BAFFLE. THE NAIL HEADS ARE LESS OBVIOUS BUT ARE VISIBLE THRU THE PAINT.

SOME 4350B MODELS HAD THE BOX GLUED INTO A $\frac{1}{2}$ " DEEP x $\frac{3}{2}$ " WIDE DADO CUT INTO THE BAFFLE. THIS METHOD IS USED ON THE 4340, 4341, 4343, 4345 AND 4355.
